St. Dunstan Athletics Friendship Dance House Rules:

- A Dance Dress Code will be enforced. Students not appropriately dressed will not be admitted.
- No sandals, flip-flops, beach shoes, platforms, high-heeled shoes of any kind, short shorts, spaghetti strap tank tops, short shirts, excessively baggy or tight clothes. Attire must be appropriate and must reflect school pride.
- Students must not wear excessive make-up and nail polish, tattoos, and artificial nails are prohibited.
- No caps or hats please.
- Late arrivals will not be allowed after 8:30pm.
- A student may not leave the center before 10pm, unless a parent comes and picks up the child. Designated secure area adjacent to the Parish Center will be opened for students who want to get some fresh air.

- Students are not allowed to loiter inside the restrooms.
- Chaperones will circulate and observe student interactions.
