Boys Baseball

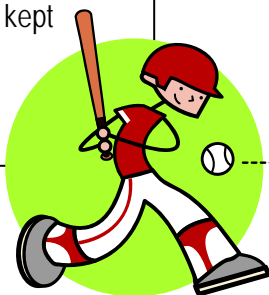
HIGHLIGHTS:
